

Group and Private Swim Lesson Rules

- 1) Payment is due before class starts.
- 2) There will be only one make up for private or group lessons, whether you miss or cancel one or more lessons.
- 3) There will be no pro-rated amounts.
- 4) Weather is always a problem in the summer. On days when it is raining or storming, we will have our swim class inside a safe area. We will go over what we've been learning, but in a dry land setting. Parents are expected to participate, if needed.
- 5) There must always be a parent or guardian present and in view during all lessons. There are no exceptions. Parents may sit and watch all lessons by the pool, and participate, if needed.
- 6) Parents could be required to come into the pool with younger children in order to ease them out of the separation anxiety phase, and into the independent swimmer phase.
- 7) Lessons need to start on time. Please have children ready with swimsuits on, goggles, towel and sun block (applied a minimum 15 minutes before entering pool).
- 8) Lessons work great, when the kids have had a nap/rest and a light snack before class if at all possible.
- 9) Enforcement of all pool rules, whether at your pool or mine, will take place once the instructor enters the pool deck.
